What is a Peugeot Health Check?

You might not notice if your vehicle isn't running at its best. That's why our Peugeot trained technicians will carry out a comprehensive health check every time your vehicle is in our workshop for service, maintenance or repair work.

As a vehicle ages it's important to regularly check its components for any wear and tear. So having a Peugeot Health Check can:

- » Find problems early to avoid vehicle failure and costly repair bills
- » Help to prevent small problems affecting your driving pleasure
- » Provide you with peace of mind that your vehicle is in the best condition

What is included:

Our Peugeot trained technicians will carry out a full visual inspection of your vehicle. This includes key items such as:

- » Bodywork
- » Braking components e.g. brake pads & discs
- » Tyres
- » Exhaust
- » Steering & Suspension
- » Lights
- » Fluid Levels
- » Battery
- » Windscreen wipers
- » Ancillary drive belt

At Peugeot we use a traffic light system to report the condition of your vehicle's components and to let you know if any action is required:

GREEN Component is working correctly on the day – no action required.

AMBER Work is not immediately necessary, but it will need to be done in the near future (of course you can choose to have work carried out on the day to save time).

RED Immediate attention is required for safety or legal reasons.

If we do find any problems, we'll tell you up-front and give you a breakdown of the costs involved for your approval.

For any amber work identified and not carried out on the day, we'll contact you when the work is due. We'll then invite you back at a time convenient for you so that we can re-assess the situation and, with your agreement, carry out the work.

Even if your vehicle's service or maintenance isn't due, you may choose to have a Peugeot Health Check. This will provide you with peace of mind that your vehicle is operating at its very best level (for instance when you're planning a long journey).
